Item	Examples
<b>Baby Furniture</b>	Cribs, beds, mattresses, strollers, playpens, baby and children's toys
<b>Crafts</b>	Needle point, hooked rug kits, embroidery kits, skeins of yarn, embroidery floss
<b>Electronics</b>	TV's, CD players, VHS/DVD players, radios, photocopiers, fax machines, telephones, mompuers, computer monitors
<b>Exercise equipment</b>	Treadmills, stationary bicycles, barbell sets
<b>Luggage</b>	Suitcases, backpacks, roll-aboard
